Continuing Care Retirement Communities (CCRCs) are designed to be environments where people often live longer, healthier, and more engaged lives. (According to a 1997 paper prepared by the Office of Disability, Aging, and Long-term Care for the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.) CCRCs offer multiple service levels and take a proactive approach to healthcare by promoting overall wellness. Benefits of a CCRC include social involvement, good nutrition, health oversight, and medication management.

Willamette View is a nationally accredited CCRC and for over 55 years has provided a selection of housing, program, service, and care options to residents; helping them pursue lifestyles full of choices and rewards. We believe wellness is not just the absence of disease, but a complete sense of well-being -- physical, emotional, spiritual, intellectual, social, and vocational.

Terrace

- Licensed Residential Care

The Terrace at Willamette offers a supportive environment as a state-licensed Residential Care Facility (RCF). And has a selection of private studio, one-bedroom, and two-bedroom apartments. The Terrace plays a vital role in the continuing care concept by providing support to those who find they want help with some of the daily activities that have become difficult to manage alone. Staff is there to assist with medication management, housekeeping, personal laundry, scheduled transportation, and personal care services. There is also an on-site Life Enrichment Coordinator and a Registered Nurse consultant. Dining at the Terrace is a social experience, with no assigned seating. The Terrace has no entrance fees. The monthly fee pays for your apartment and a basic supportive services package.

The Health Center offers 24-hour staffing. As a multi-licensed facility with no entrance fees, the Health Center offers a range of rehabilitative, supportive, and nursing services in a social setting.

Health Center staff support the philosophy of person-centered care... creating an environment with multiple levels as well as choices in services and how those services are delivered.

Residents' life-long patterns and meaningful activities are incorporated into their individualized service packages and care plans.

Post-hospitalization care and skilled nursing are in the Short Stay wing of the Health Center. Short Stay rooms are available to Willamette View residents at no charge for the first two days of their stay, per episode of illness.

The Terrace and Health Center are designated non-smoking residential care, assisted living, and skilled care buildings.

Home Care — To Your Home from Willamette View

To Your Home in-home care provides a wide range of support services to residents in their homes. Services include personal care and assistance with the daily activities of living, respite care, transportation, meal preparation, shopping, social outings, and travel companions. Nursing services include supervision and oversight, medication set up and management, and compliance with physician care and treatment plans. Services packages are customized to meet individual needs, from non-medical to around-the-clock care giving.
